
UNINSURED RATE FELL NATIONALLY AND IN 39 STATES IN 2016


AMERICAN COMMUNITY SURVEY (ACS)

New data from the ACS show that the nation's uninsured rate declined significantly in 2016, falling 0.8 percentage points from 9.4% in 2015 to 8.6% in 2016. This drop in uninsurance has continued each year since the historic drop between 2013 and 2014. Uninsurance also fell significantly in 39 states in 2016. Eleven states saw no significant change in uninsurance, and no state reported a significant increase.


NATIONAL UNINSURED RATE OVER TIME, 2010-2016




DECLINE IN STATE UNINSURED RATES, 2015-2016
