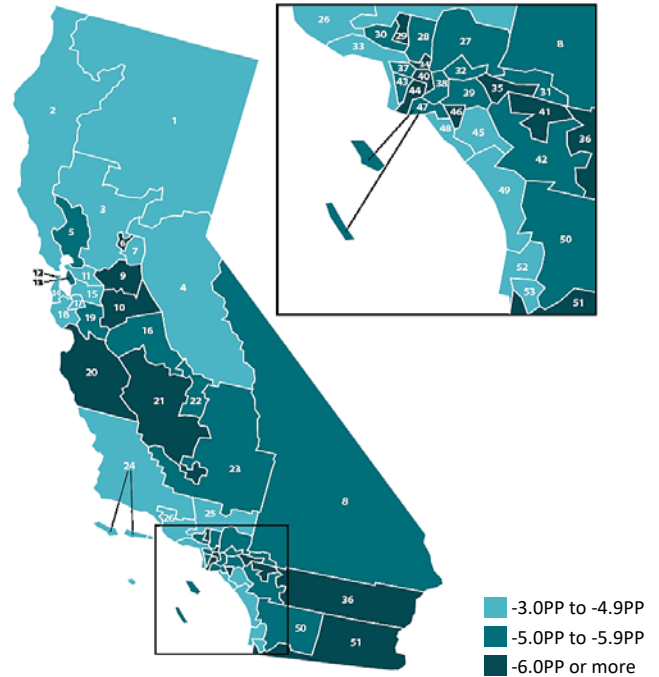

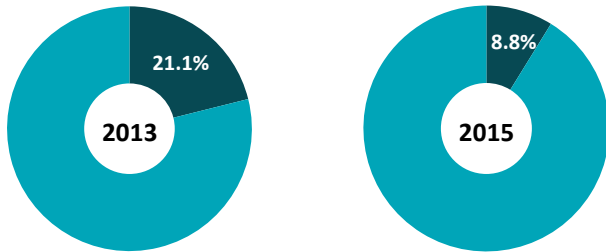
PERCENT CHANGE IN UNINSURED



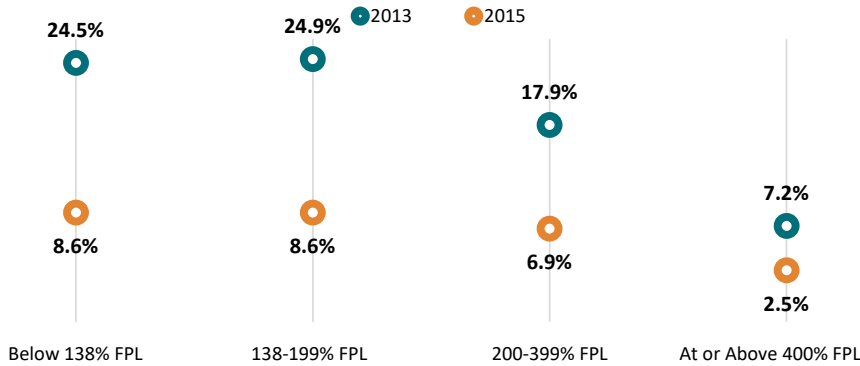
PERCENTAGE POINT CHANGE IN UNINSURED BY CD



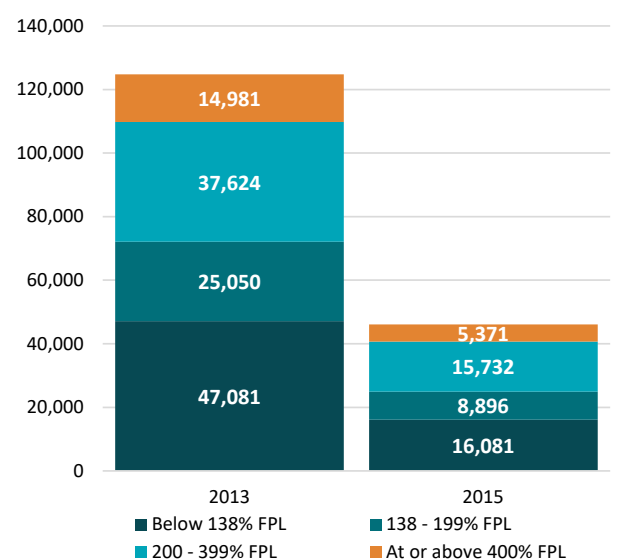
UNINSURANCE AMONG THE EMPLOYED



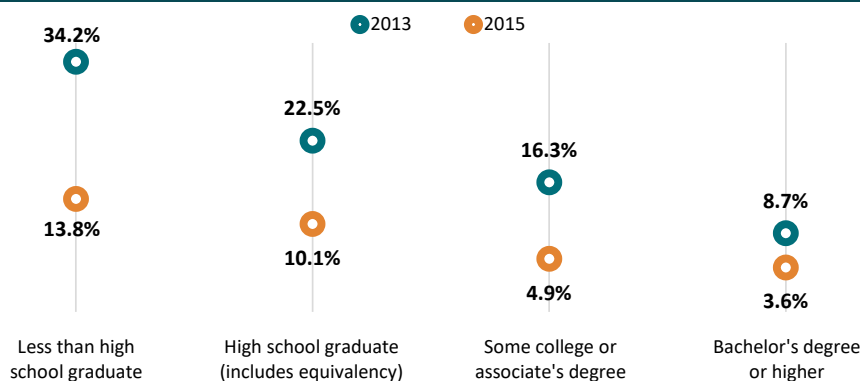
PERCENT UNINSURED BY INCOME, 2013 - 2015
