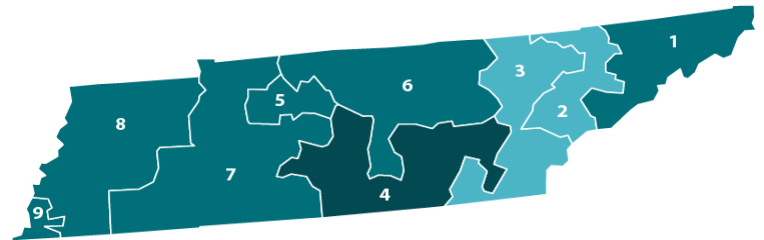

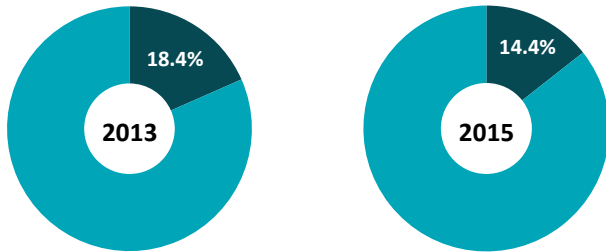
#### PERCENT CHANGE IN UNINSURED



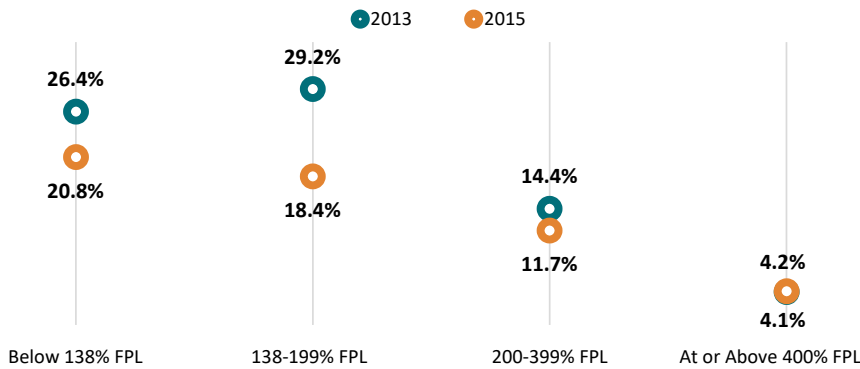
#### PERCENTAGE POINT CHANGE IN UNINSURED BY CD



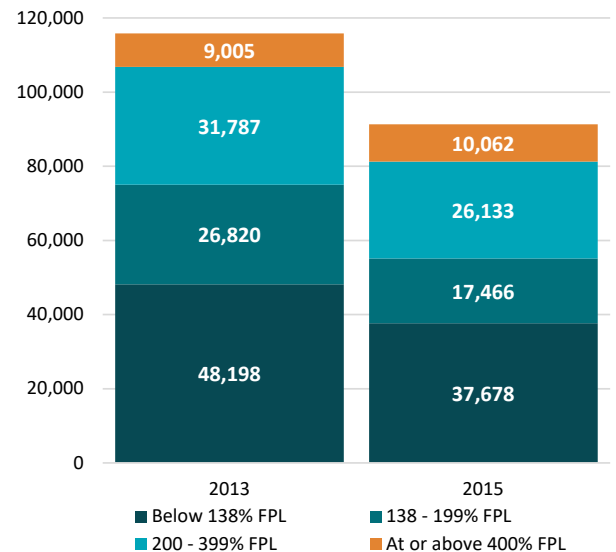
#### UNINSURANCE AMONG THE EMPLOYED



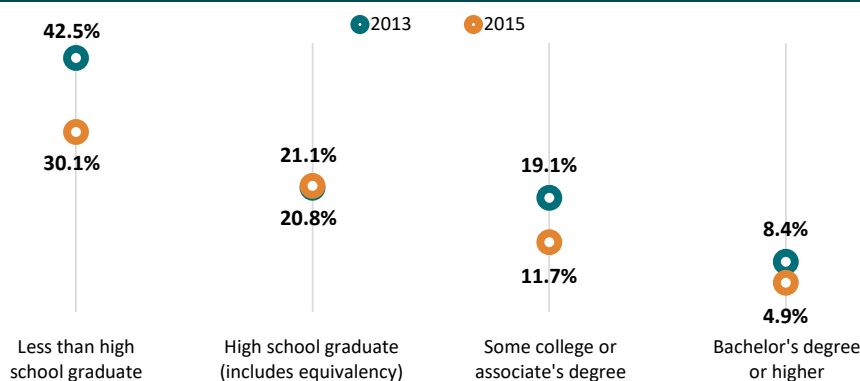
#### PERCENT UNINSURED BY INCOME, 2013 - 2015
