

2007 Minnesota Health Access Survey: Preliminary Results

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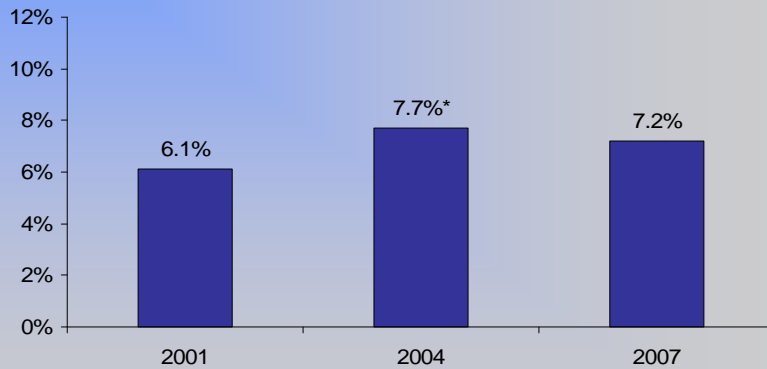


Background

- ★ Survey conducted in partnership between Minnesota Department of Health and University of Minnesota School of Public Health
 - Previous surveys in 2001 and 2004
- ★ Over 9,700 households were included in the 2007 survey
- ★ Survey conducted between July and December 2007
- ★ Statistical weights used to ensure that survey results are representative of the population
 - For comparability with 2007 results, the weights for 2001 and 2004 survey results were re-calculated



Uninsurance Rate Trends in Minnesota, 2001 to 2007

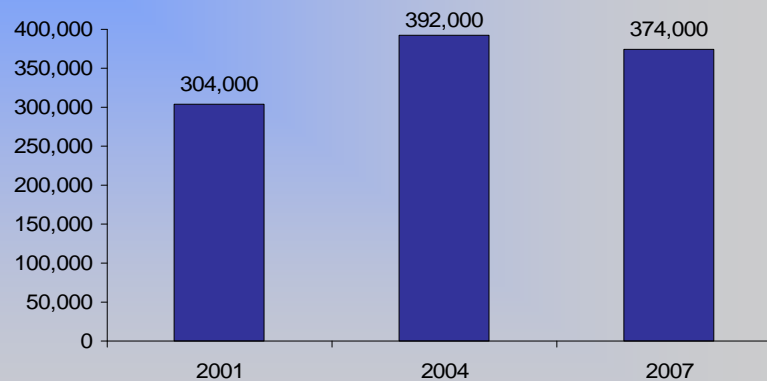

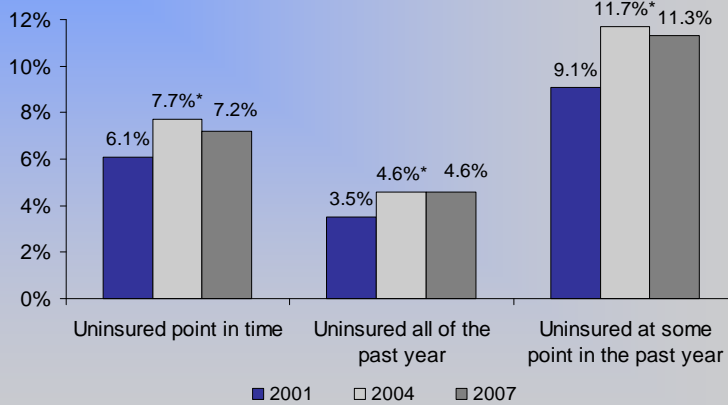
Estimated Number of Uninsured in Minnesota, 2001 to 2007

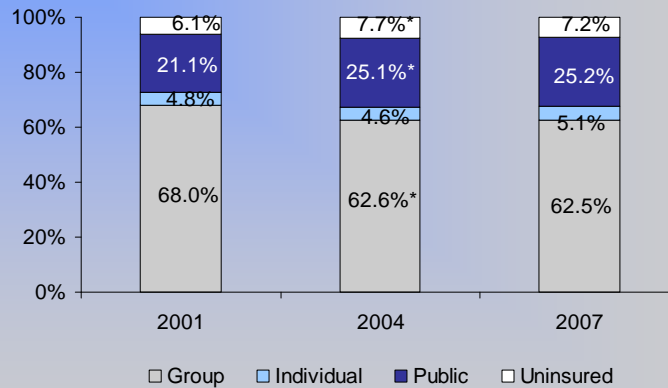
Measures of Uninsurance in Minnesota, 2001 to 2007

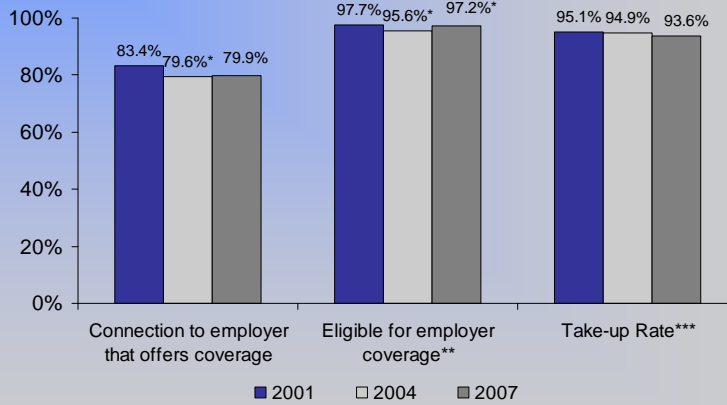
Sources of Insurance Coverage in Minnesota, 2001 to 2007

Access to Employer Coverage, 2001 to 2007 (Non-elderly population)



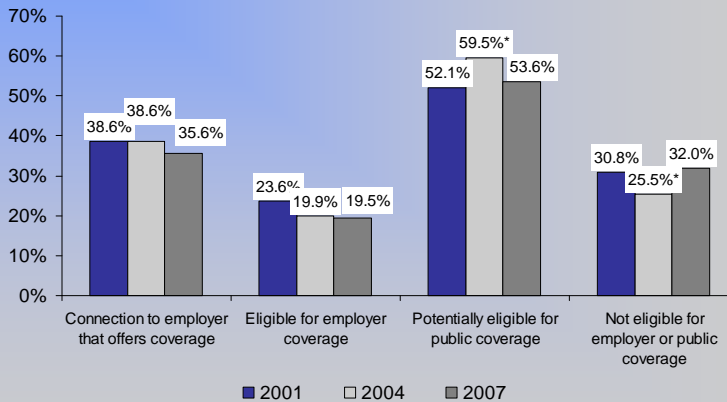

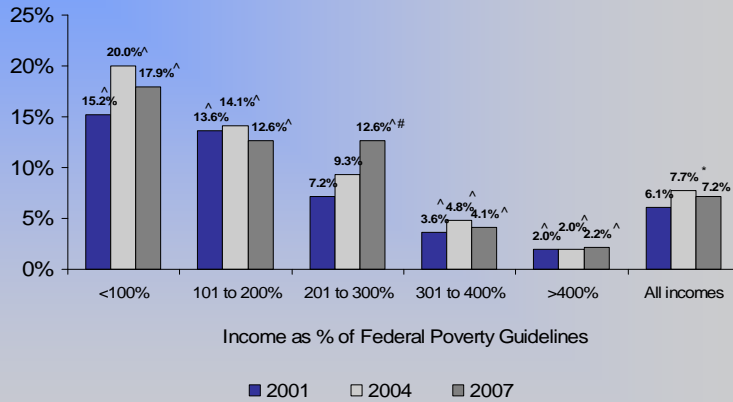

Uninsurance Rates by Income, 2001 to 2007



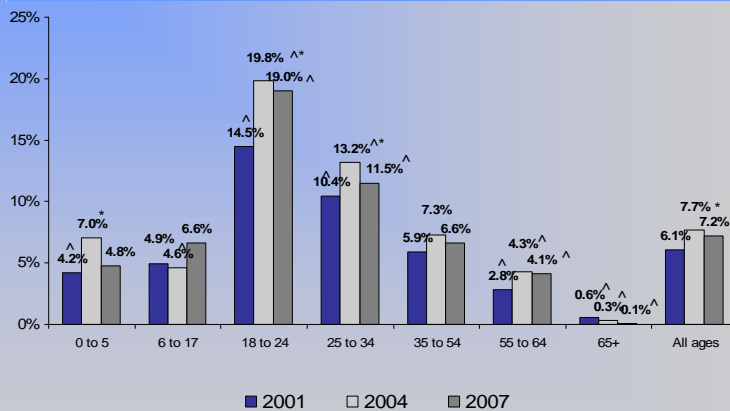

Uninsurance Rates by Age, 2001 to 2007



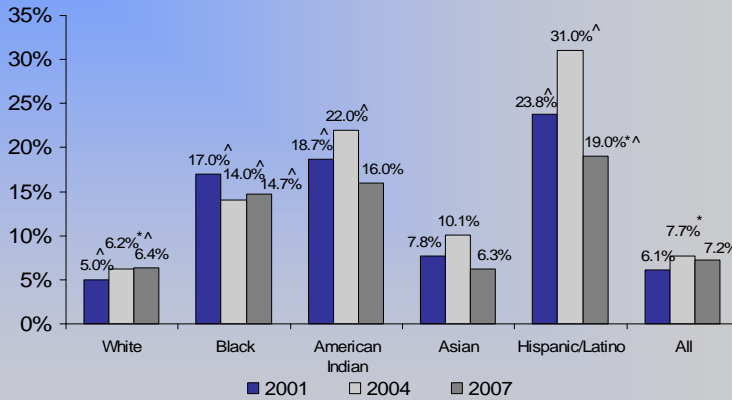

Uninsurance Rates by Race and Ethnicity, 2001 to 2007



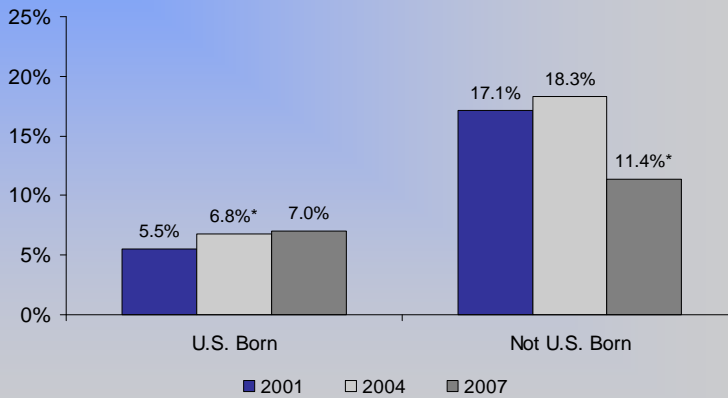

Uninsurance Rates by Country of Birth, 2001 to 2007

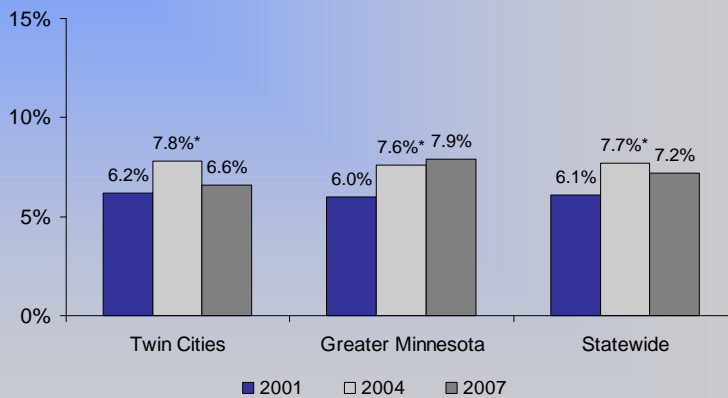

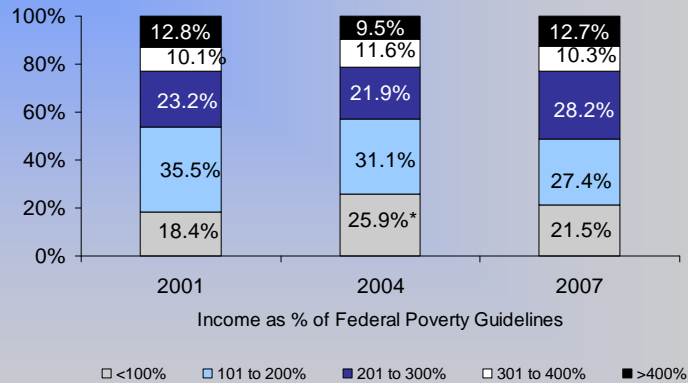

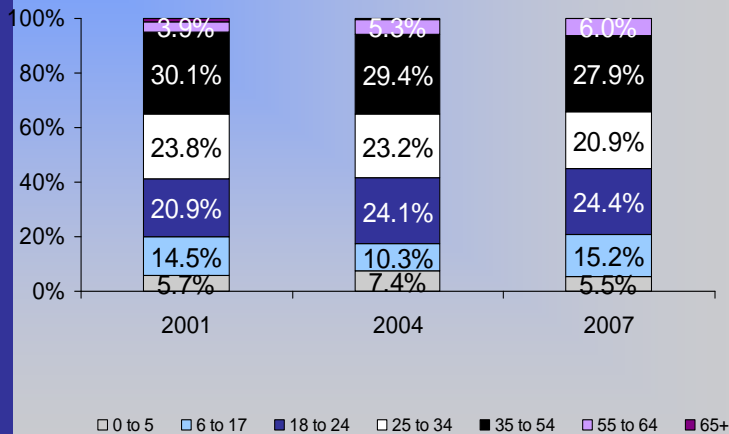
Income Distribution of Minnesota's Uninsured Population, 2001 to 2007

Summary

- ★ From 2004 to 2007, the uninsurance rate was stable in Minnesota after increasing from 2001 to 2004
- ★ The share of the population with employer based health insurance stabilized
- ★ There continue to be large differences in insurance status by income, age, and race/ethnicity



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
