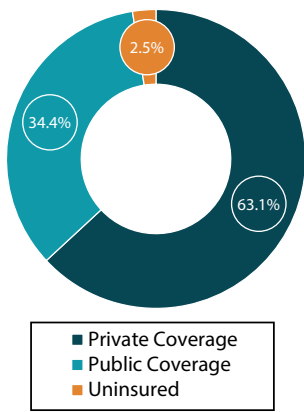


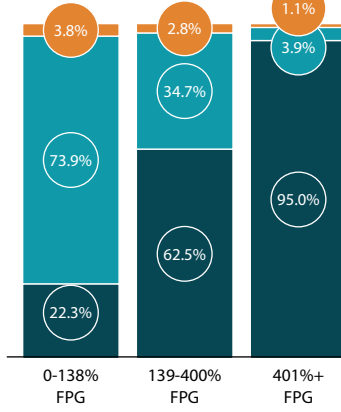

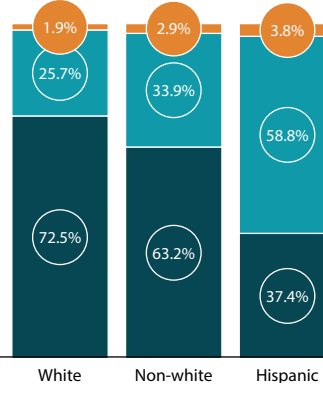

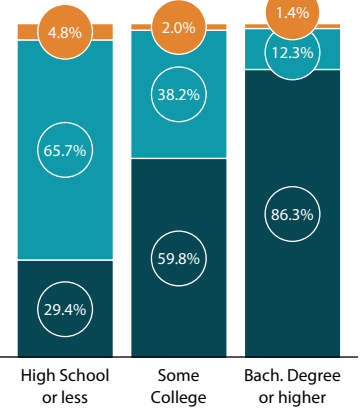
BY INCOME



BY RACE/ETHNICITY

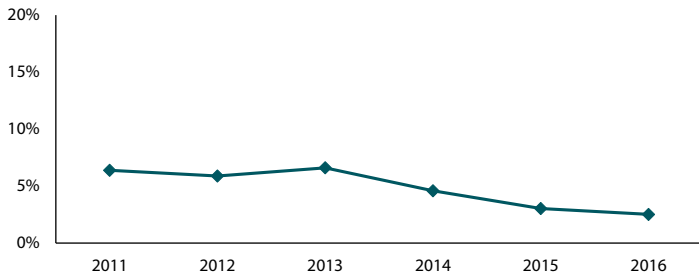

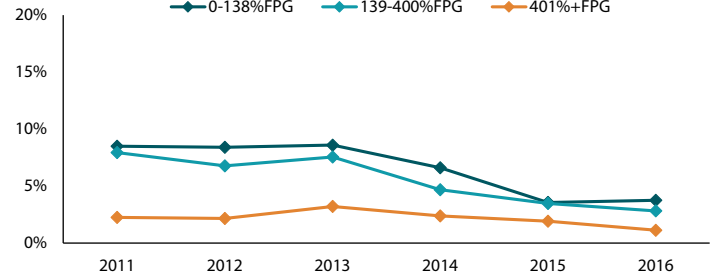

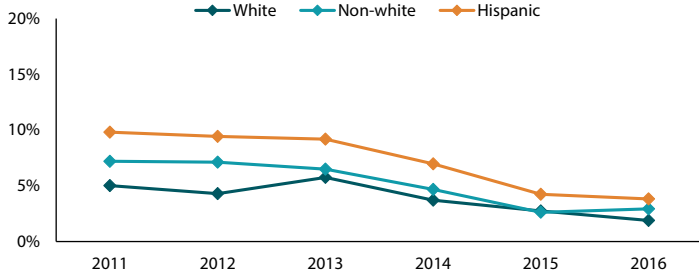
UNINSURED, ALL CHILDREN



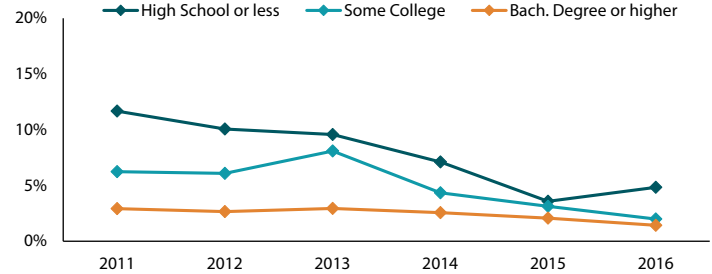
UNINSURED CHILDREN BY INCOME



UNINSURED CHILDREN BY RACE/ETHNICITY



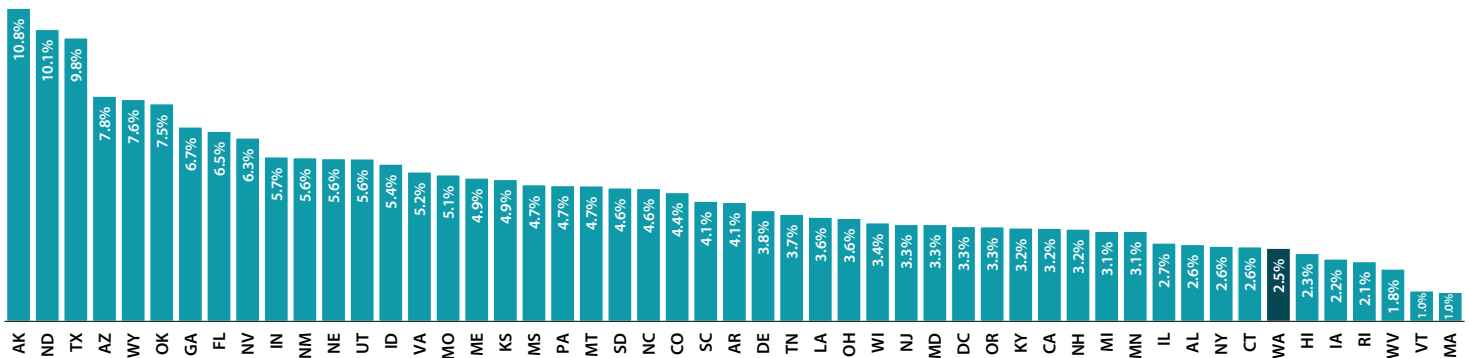
UNINSURED CHILDREN BY HOUSEHOLD EDUCATION
